Paint Your Spot (PYS) Senior Tradition

GOAL(S): This year JHS Senior student drivers will have the opportunity to paint/personalize a parking space on campus. Goals were established to better serve students aligned with the [JISD & JHS Vision & Mission](#):

1. A positive morale and culture at JHS.
2. Students to participate in JHS traditions
3. To create a FUN, positive campus climate.

JHS PYS REDESIGN

Below are key elements that **Seniors** at JHS will need to know and follow for the PYS program:

- The parking spots are limited to Seniors and on a first come, first serve basis.
- The spot an individual gets approved to paint is their parking spot for the *entire* school year.
- Complete the **PYS Registration Form** (see below).
- **You must EMAIL the PYS Registration Form for Spot Approval to james.larremore@jarrellisd.org**
- Designs must be submitted on the Paint Your Spot Registration Form. Think of your space as a shirt you would wear to school. Your parking spot must meet dress code approval. Keep it classy and make it fun! If a spot is painted that is deemed inappropriate, no reimbursement will be provided. **Prohibited** items will be painted over and disciplinary action may be taken; you may forfeit your right to a parking space and/or to park on campus.
 - **Allowed:**
 - Positive quotes, slogans, and pictures that enhance and add value to JHS.
 - Programs, clubs, fine arts, athletics, or any clubs or organization positive promotion that you are a part of AT JHS.
 - **You may use YOUR NAME.** If you want to use a nickname it must be approved.
 - **Prohibited:**

A copy of your CURRENT Driver License and Insurance is required and must be kept up-to-date throughout the school year with the front office.

- Offensive or obscene language, pictures, or symbols.
 - Political sayings, pictures, campaigns, or words.
 - Negative or rude language (be nice).
 - Violence or hurtful pictures or words.
 - Handicap Symbols or symbols that may cause confusion.
 - “Gang-style tagging,” alcohol, drugs, advertisement of or illegal activities.
 - Double entendre (double meaning) words/phrases.
 - Any design deemed inappropriate by JHS Administration.
 - A boyfriend’s or girlfriend’s name is **NOT** allowed.
- If someone paints prior to Spot Approval, they will be denied a PYS. Reimbursement will not be provided for denied PYS.
 - **Seniors will pay for a PYS for \$50.** This is for your Parking Permit AND PYS. This needs to be submitted with or upon submission of the PYS Registration Form. No unpaid PYS applicants will be accepted or approved. No reimbursement of any kind will be provided once payment is made.
 - Payment Options:
 - Cash or Check made out to Jarrell High School (Office staff will not be back on campus until 7/29/19.)

 - You must provide electronic or paper receipt of payment online with submission of the PYS Registration Form for proof. This is the quickest/easiest payment method.
 - **PRIOR to submitting the Senior Clearance Form at end of year:**
 - Seniors will remove or paint over their spot in black water-based exterior latex paint before being approved to walk at Graduation; this will be a part of their Senior Clearance Form.

 - **WHY?:**
 - To beautify the campus
 - To build school spirit and positive school culture and climate
 - To create a senior tradition
 - To support JHS
 - **What Spot?:**
 - PYS per the Spot Approval. Location of Your Spot will be determined via Spot Approval based on the PYS Registration Form. **You must follow this design exactly – no changes allowed. DO NOT cover the Parking Lot lines.**
 - **What can I use?:**
 - Paint with any household interior or exterior paint. WATER

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BASED LATEX paint is the only type of paint that can be used. All paint will be the responsibility of the student.

■ **Other supplies needed:**

Be sure to FOLLOW your approved design/sketches. Also, you will be responsible for all paint brushes, rollers, paint pans and paint tape. A broom to sweep off your spot before painting will save you lots of time. You will want to bring lawn chairs for your entire family, a canopy or market umbrella, sunscreen, drinks, stencils, rags for cleaning, sacks or bags to dispose of trash, a drop cloth and paint clothes if you want to enjoy the painting event. This will be a really fun activity for the entire family and or friends and we hope to make this a great memorable tradition for all Seniors for years to follow!

The purpose of allowing Senior students to paint their own parking spot is aimed at improving school pride and camaraderie. Students can "own" a piece of the school. We encourage students to express themselves through positive artwork.

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved PYS:

- Upon purchasing my parking spot I will only use water-based exterior latex paint. **JHS and/or JISD is not held liable for any problems, outcomes, or issues when the spot is painted.**
- I know I am not allowed spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- I will only paint within the marked parking space that is drawn for me.
- I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot.
- I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space.
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my parking space.
- **I understand that my painted design must be completed by August 14, 2018 before 6 pm.**
- **If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will be taken away and will be painted over, and I will not receive a refund.**
- If I park in someone else's painted parking spot, I will receive disciplinary action and possible fines.
- I agree to paint over my design in black water-based exterior latex paint at the end of the school year as a part of my Senior Clearance Form. If it is not completed by the day The Senior Clearance Form is due, I understand I may not be able to walk at Graduation as this will be a part of their Senior Clearance Form expectations and this Registration Form.
- ***JHS and/or JISD is not held liable for any problems, accidents, or issues when you Paint Your Spot.**

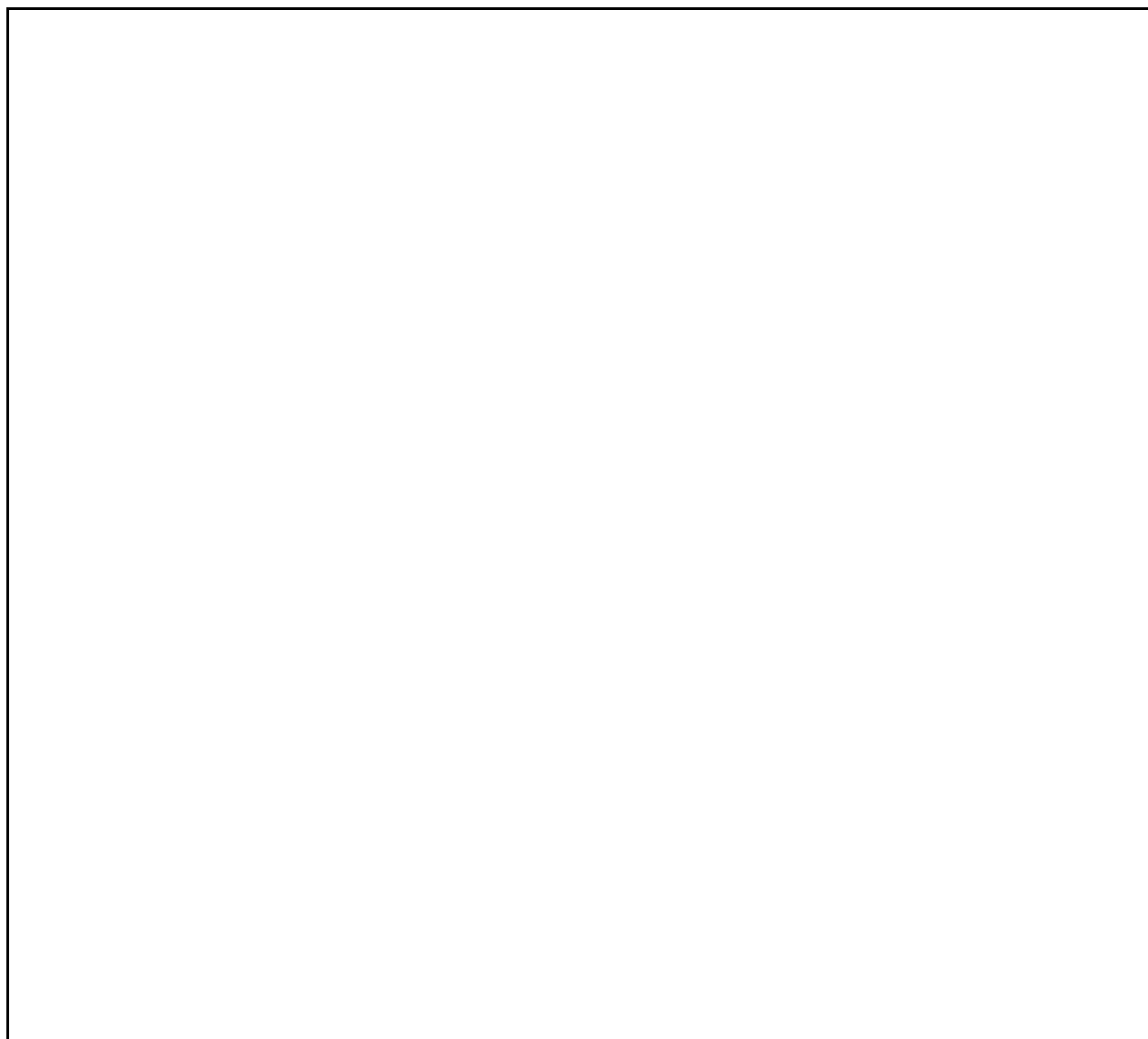
